The average price for a small student studio is about 400 euros. Usually a deposit corresponding to 2 or 3 monthly rents is required.

➤ Important information

- Usually, a deposit corresponding to 2 or 3 rents is required by the owner (or the accommodation agency) at the moment of the booking. So do not forget to prepare a high amount for your accommodation at the moment of your arrival!
- Most of the time, a minimum salary amount is required to obtain an accommodation (the usual rule is that the rent amount must correspond to less than one third of your monthly salary of the last three months). If your income is lower than the minimum requirement, you can ask somebody to be your “garant” (person declared as responsible for your rent payments in case of payment incapacity). Your “garant” must live in France.
- If you decide to leave your accommodation, you have to notice the owner (or the accommodation agency) 1 or 3 months in advance, depending on your contract.
